

COVID 19 Message from the Safety officer:

We must do our part to prevent any of our gatherings from contributing to the spread of COVID19! With this goal in mind, we have taken input from the CDC, the AMA, state of Michigan and park management and developed rules to follow:

- It is a good idea to act as if anyone outside your family/cohorts is potentially infected because COVID-19 can be spread from an infected person who does not exhibit symptoms.
- Practice social distancing (6' of separation) at all times all not from the same household.
- Wear a mask for situations that are difficult to maintain social distancing. Wearing a mask is for the protection of others, not just yourself.
- Perform regular handwashing, or use of hand sanitizer after touching any shared surfaces.
- If you or someone begins to exhibit symptoms or feel sick, encourage them to go home or seek medical attention.
- You MUST sign in! For contact tracing purposes anyone who tests positive within 14 days of the date of visiting shall have the club safety officer notified. In order to maintain privacy of the individual you can have this done through a representative (i.e. a contact tracer or health official) should call 248-677-1223 to notify. The club will make every effort to maintain privacy of the individual!
- Discuss these rules and other preventative measures at pilots' meetings.

Please refrain from coming to any of our activities if you...

- have traveled internationally by air or returned from a cruise in the last 14 days.
- had close contact with a diagnosed COVID19 patient in the last 14 days or awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test
- are currently experiencing Fever, Chills, Cough, Difficulty Breathing, Headache, Sore Throat, Muscle/Joint Aches, Diarrhea, Abdominal Cramps or Nausea, Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye), Loss of Taste or Smell.
- If you engage in activities that are widely considered high risk behavior (COVID parties, mass gatherings without masks/social distancing) that could lead to an infection outside of our club activities in the last 14 days.
